Sprint Local Ordering Guidelines

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1.1 This document is issued to clarify current definitions and business rules of Sprint LTD. Any additions, deletions and significant changes are summarized in the section titled “Synopsis of Change.”
- 1.2 Options described in each section are based on Sprint LTD tariffs and business rules. Within this document the business rules are described from a manual perspective. There are cross references to specific fields within Integrated Request Entry System (IRES) and supported File Transfer Protocol (FTP).
- 1.3 This document may contain certain fields that are supported by industry standards, but are not supported by Sprint LTD. These fields will be identified with a description in usage of “This field is not supported by Sprint LTD.”
- 1.4 When the following usage message states “This field is not supported by Sprint LTD” it only indicates that this field is not supported within the specific section. If the field is applicable at an account level, the user will be referred to a specific named section, for example “See End User Section.” If the field is applicable at a line level, user will not be referred to the specific named section, for example “See individual sections.”
- 1.5 The local service ordering guideline incorporates the following requirements for the population of form entries.
- Required - R field must be populated.
 - Optional - O field may or may not be populated.
 - Prohibited - P field must not be populated.
 - Conditional - C field is dependent upon the relationship to another entry as specified in the usage statement and is dependent upon the presence, absence or combination of other data entries.

1.6 Denoted by “X” are the valid Request and Activity Types offered by Sprint LTD. The reason Request Type B and C have LNP and INP is because a situation may occur when Sprint LTD must internally port telephone numbers where Local Number Portability (LNP) is not available within a particular wire center. This will be noted as Interim Number Portability (INP). Business rules may differ between LNP and INP.
