- All call placements charges, connection fees and surcharges apply per call.
- A customer's phone line may not be classified as a "business", "public" or "semi-public" line. The customer's account may not have more than four residential phone line associated with its account and each household is limited to two 500 Home LD for \$19.99 Market Test accounts for each Sprint PCS account. A customer must subscribe to 500 Home LD for \$19.99 Market Test for outbound Dial-1 service.
- The customer's phone line may not be in housing associated with educational institutions.
- The customer may not use this service for commercial use, for connection to the Internet, for other data services (including facsimile transmissions) or for any other use that does not involve a person-to-person conversation or voice message.
- The 500 minutes of Dial-1 usage does not include usage from multi-party conference calls, calls to 900 NPAs, calls to Directory Assistance, FONCARD Service, operator service or inbound toll free service.
- If Sprint determines that the service is not being used for individual residential service or in any other way violates the restrictions of this service, Sprint may suspend or terminate the subscriber's service.
- This market test is not available to Sprint employees and available for enrollment through September 30, 2002, unless sooner changed or canceled by Sprint.
- Other surcharges and fees may apply, including (but not limited to) Carrier Property Tax, Carrier Universal Service Charge, Frequent Flyer Excise Charge, Gross Receipts Tax Surcharge, and International Mobile Termination Surcharge.
