Options – Except for the rates below, the international rates, the state-to-state rates, and the terms and conditions of <a href="#">Sprint 7¢ AnyTime</a> apply.	
Sprint 7¢ AnyTime with Internet I	For a monthly recurring charge of \$21.95, the customer receives both Internet service and <a href="#">Sprint 7¢ AnyTime</a> service.
Sprint 7¢ AnyTime with Internet II  Sprint FONCARD Per Minute Rates and Per Call Connection Fee	For a monthly recurring charge of \$19.95, a customer will receive Internet service and <a href="#">Sprint 7¢ AnyTime</a> service.  <a href="#">Sprint FONCARD Option 8</a> rates will apply instead of Sprint FONCARD Option 6 rates. Except for the MRC, all other <a href="#">Sprint 7¢ AnyTime</a> rates apply.  A customer who subscribes to this option must pick Sprint as their intraLATA carrier.
Sprint 7¢ AnyTime for PCS or Nextel@	This option is available to customers who have Sprint PCS or Nextel service. A customer who subscribes to this option must pick Sprint as their intraLATA carrier. No MRC applies. All other Sprint 7¢ Anytime rates apply.

- A customer who subscribes to the Sprint 7¢ AnyTime for PCS or Nextel option will not be charged the Single Bill Fee.
- If a Sprint 7¢ AnyTime for PCS or Nextel customer cancels Sprint PCS, Nextel or intraLATA service, they will be switched to Sprint 7¢ AnyTime. All rates, terms and conditions of Sprint 7¢ AnyTime will apply.
- Beginning February 28, 2003, any customer disconnecting their intraLATA service associated with Sprint 7¢ AnyTime with Internet II, before or after this date, will be switched to Sprint 7¢ AnyTime with Internet I.
- A customer's account may not have more than one residential phone line associated with its account and each household is limited to one Sprint 7¢ AnyTime Option account. A customer must have an individual residential phone line service from Sprint, the local exchange company or mobile service provider presubscribed to Sprint for interstate long distance service.

\* As of April 29, 2005, except for Ohio, Sprint 7¢ AnyTime with Internet I and Sprint 7¢ AnyTime with Internet II services will no longer be available to new customers. The change for Ohio will be effective June 30, 2005.

@ Effective October 1, 2006, Sprint 7¢ AnyTime for PCS or Nextel will no longer be available to new customers.

**(No Longer Offered)**

- Customers that are inadvertently subscribed to a plan that is not offered in their area will be moved to the associated plan for which they qualify following 30 days' notification.
- All calls are billed in whole minute increments. Partial minutes are rounded up to the next whole minute.
- All call placements charges, connection fees and surcharges apply per call.
- A customer's phone line may not be classified as a "business", "public" or "semi-public" line. The service was available to residential customers who have selected Sprint as their primary interexchange carrier.
- For country termination points and state-to-state call definitions, see [Service Availability](#).
- This service is available for use by individuals residing at a single-family residence, including but not limited to a house, condominium, or apartment, where service is being provided. This service is not available in group or multi-family housing, including but not limited to housing associated with educational institutions or military barracks.
- Dial-1 long distance voice usage provided under this service offering applies on a per line basis only and does not include usage associated with: Sprint FONCARD calls; calls which are pay for use, including calls to 900, 976, 555 and 700 numbers; calls to Directory Assistance calls which involve an operator service, including emergency interrupt; and toll free service.
- Use of any feature, including but not limited to call forwarding, on a planned and continuing basis to allow an originating caller to avoid long distance charges is prohibited.
- If Sprint determines that the service is not being used for individual residential service, or in any other way violates the restrictions of this service, Sprint may suspend or terminate the customer's service.
- Other surcharges and fees may apply, including (but not limited to) Carrier Cost Recovery Charge, Carrier Universal Service Charge, Frequent Flyer Excise Charge, Gross Receipts Tax Surcharge, International Mobile Termination Surcharge and Single Bill Fee. In addition, state Universal Service Fund charges may also apply to interstate and/or international services.
