Information concerning local service may be found in Sprint's applicable local tariffs.
- All calls are billed in whole minute increments. Partial minutes are rounded up to the next whole minute.
- All call placement charges, connection fees and surcharges apply per call.
- The service is available to residential customers who have selected Sprint as their primary interexchange carrier.

- A customer's phone line may not be classified as a "business", "public" or "semi-public" line.
- The customer's phone line may not be in housing associated with educational institutions.
- The customer may not use this service for commercial use, for connection to the Internet, for other data services (including facsimile transmissions) or for any other use that does not involve a person-to-person conversation or voice message.
- Usage does not include usage from multi-party conference calls, calls to 900 NPAs, or calls to Directory Assistance.
- If Sprint determines that the service is not being used for individual residential service, or in any other way violates the restrictions of this service, Sprint may suspend or terminate the customer's service.
- Other surcharges and fees may apply, including (but not limited to) Carrier Cost Recovery Charge, Carrier Universal Service Charge, Frequent Flyer Excise Charge, Gross Receipts Tax Surcharge, International Mobile Termination Surcharge and Single Bill Fee.
