FlexTime Market Tests¹

Beginning November 18, 1999, Sprint will test market five "FlexTime" Sprint PCS block-of-time-type calling plans which will utilize combined billing and integrated minutes of use. Combined billing allows customers to receive one bill for both their Sprint home long distance (wireline) and their Sprint PCS (wireless) service. Two of these "FlexTime" plans will allow for the combination of interstate wireline and wireless usage for purposes of meeting the block-of-time minutes cap. All minutes of use above the cap will incur an applicable Sprint interstate wireline per minute (as shown below) or Sprint PCS wireless per minute rate. Any unused minutes will not roll over to the next month. Three of the plans will allow for any unused minutes of the customer's Sprint PCS Free and Clear plan to be applied to the customer's home interstate wireline usage. An additional monthly recurring charge may apply to these plans, as shown below:

- (1) FlexTime Market Test A and FlexTime Market Test B offer the following bundled minute options: 180, 450, 500, 650, 700, or 1200. Any interstate wireline dial-1, FONCARD or toll free usage over the bundled minutes will be rated at \$0.10 per minute. No per call surcharge or additional MRC will apply.
- (2) FlexTime Market Tests C, D, and E offer the ability to apply unused Sprint PCS Free and Clear minutes against interstate wireline dial-1, FONCARD or toll free minutes of use. Any minutes used above the Free and Clear cap will be billed at the applicable long distance wireline (as shown in (1) above) or Sprint PCS wireless per minute rates. The following MRCs apply by market test: Market C - \$9.99, Market D - \$4.99 and Market E - \$0.00.

Market Test Availability: Customers enrolling in these market tests must have Sprint as the customer's primary interexchange carrier for the customer's wireline services. The market tests will be available as follows: A- Hartford, CT; B - New Orleans, LA; C - Denver, CO; D-Omaha, NE and E - Indianapolis, IN.

These market tests will be available for enrollment through January 16, 2000 unless sooner changed or canceled by Sprint
