Sprint Sense Home Office - \$100 Market Test Service¹

Beginning November 1, 1997, Sprint will test market its Sprint Sense Home Office - \$100 service as described herein. The Sprint Sense Home Office - \$100 service allows the customer to place 1000 minutes of combined intrastate and interstate Dial-1, FONCARD, toll free and mobile phone calling without incurring additional charges in return for a monthly recurring charge of \$100. Unused minutes of usage cannot carry over into the next month. Any combined domestic Dial-1, FONCARD, toll free and mobile phone usage above 1000 minutes in the month will be billed at \$0.10 per minute, 7 days a week, 24 hours a day. All calls are billed in 60 second increments with each fractional minute rounded up to the next full minute. In addition, the monthly recurring charge associated with the customer's toll free service will be waived. Finally, domestic FONCARD calls will not incur a per call surcharge. Sprint Sense Home Office - \$100 is available to new and existing Sprint Sense II customers who have selected Sprint as the subscriber's primary interexchange carrier. Sprint Sense Home Office - \$100 is not available to those residential customers whose home phone line is classified as a "commercial line". In addition, the potential Sprint Sense Home Office - \$100 customer must have multiple services in order to enroll in this market test. The Sprint Sense Home Office - \$100 service is available to subscribers in the U.S. Mainland only. Operator services, directory assistance and international minutes do not contribute to the 1000 minutes. All other applicable rates, terms and conditions of Sprint Sense II will apply. This market test is available for enrollment through December 31, 1997 unless sooner changed or canceled by Sprint. Upon expiration of the enrollment period, customers of this test market service will continue to receive the rates, terms and conditions of this test market service, which may change from time to time, until such time as Sprint discontinues the service. At that time, the customer will be given the choice of (1) returning to the customer's previous Sprint service or (2) switching to another Sprint service.
