**(No Longer Offered)**

**Sprint Unlimited Domestic Dial-1 Market Test #2**

Beginning June 3, 2000, Sprint will test market an unlimited domestic dial-1 service as described herein. The unlimited domestic dial-1 market test service allows the customer to place unlimited local toll, intrastate and interstate dial-1 calls each month without incurring any usage charges for these calls. A monthly recurring charge ("MRC") of \$65.00 per account will apply each month or partial month and will be billed in advance of service, except for the initial month (or fraction thereof). The MRC for the initial month (or fraction thereof) will be billed on the customer's first invoice. Specifically, the first bill the customer receives will include a MRC for the first month (or a pro-rated MRC for a partial month) plus the MRC for the next month's (or pro-rated month's) service. The following rates apply to all other types of services under this market test.

- (1) Interstate FONCARD calls will be rated at the per minute rate and per call surcharge in Section 5.6.9.a.(1) herein.
- (2) Interstate Operator Service calls will be rated at the per minute rates in Section 5.6.8.A and the applicable per call connection fees in Section 5.6.8.B herein.
- (3) Interstate Toll Free Service is available as an add-on option to this market test. The rates, terms and conditions of Section 5.6.30.B.3 herein will apply.
- (4) International Rates: The rates described in Sections 5.2.EE.4.a (dial-1), 5.2.EE.4.b (operator service and FONCARD) and 5.2.EE.4.c (Sprint International Access) will apply.

This market test is available only to (1) customers who reside in the state of California, and (2) customers who are presubscribed to Sprint for local toll. This market test will be available to a maximum of 1000 customers. This market test is available for sign-up until 1000 customers have been enrolled or through August 4, 2000, whichever comes first. Customers will receive the rates, terms and conditions of this market test, which may change from time to time, until such time as Sprint discontinues the service. At that time, the customer will be given the choice of (1) returning to the customer's previous Sprint service or (2) switching to another Sprint service.
